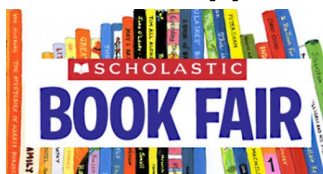

****If you volunteer as a new team coach, your child will automatically be placed on your team. All other new team members will be selected by a lottery. If there are openings on an existing team, the spot will be filled by lottery by June 8th, 2022.**
