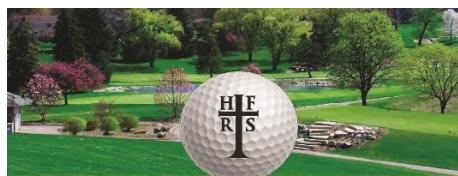

### **First Lego League/ First Technical Challenge Registration Form**

- ☐ FIRST Lego League: **Grades 4, 5** Teams will be assigned in May of the current school year **only** if we have volunteer team coaches. Maximum 8 students on a team. **The last day for team registration is May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022.** Your coach will have the option of meeting during the summer months. Program officially runs from September through November, with the state competition shortly thereafter. (Additional costs for competitions) **Fee is \$125.00.** Additional fees may apply if a team qualifies for state.
- ☐ FIRST Technical Challenge: **Grades 6,7,8** Teams will be assigned in May **only** if we have volunteer team coaches. Maximum 15 students on a team. **The last day for team registration is May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022.** Program officially runs from September – December. **Fee is \$125.00.** Additional fees (hotel, food, transportation) may apply if they qualify for state competition.

**\*\*If you volunteer as a new team coach, your child will automatically be placed on your team. All other new team members will be selected by a lottery. If there are openings on an existing team, the spot will be filled by lottery by June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022.**
