The Ascension of the Lord

Sunday, May 29, 2022

This weekend we will celebrate the Solemnity of the *Ascension of the Lord*. This is an apostolic observance, meaning we believe Jesus rose full body to Heaven because the apostles saw it and proclaimed it. Most Christian traditions celebrate this great event.

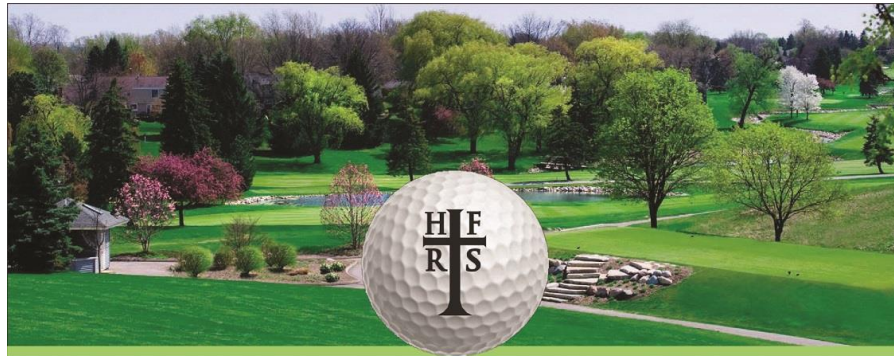
We believe that Jesus Christ, born of the Blessed Virgin Mary, was fully human and fully divine. He is the second person of the Blessed Trinity and was crucified, died and buried but rose on the third day just as the scriptures said.

Jesus appeared and reappeared to His apostles, teaching them and breaking bread with them, for forty days. On that fortieth day they watched Him *ascend into Heaven full body*. Can you imagine how they felt as this happened? Firstly, what a miracle to watch Him raised up, secondly, they just regained their dear friend from death. They loved Him and they depended on Him.

So, what did the apostles do after Jesus left them? They prayed in Jerusalem with Mary for nine days...this was the beginning of our Novena tradition. They knew what they were supposed to do ... to go out and continue the work of their Teacher, their Lord, their Savior...but did they have the courage and the knowledge. Would they make the right decisions, and were they worthy enough to take on this role?

In ten days, we will celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit sent to Jesus' apostles. The Holy Spirit gave them what they needed to go out and be Christ to all.

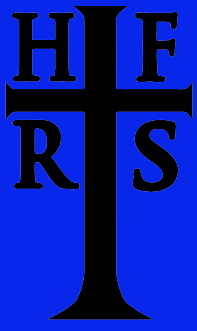

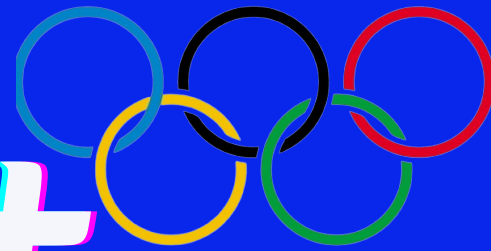

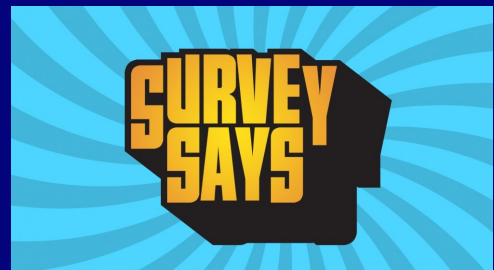
