

2022 Asphalt Road Resurfacing Project

THE CITY OF ROCHESTER HAS SCHEDULED TO REPAIR THE ROADWAY WITHIN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD. THE REPAIR WORK WILL CONSIST OF REMOVING & REPLACING THE TOP (2") LAYER OF ASPHALT PAVEMENT.

THE PAVEMENT RESURFACING WILL BEGIN ON WENDSDAY, AUGUST 31ST, BY MILLING THE TOP (2") LAYER OF ASPHALT PAVEMENT. ONCE THE REMOVAL IS COMPLETE, THE CONTRACTOR WILL REPAIR THE STONE BASE UNDER ROADS AT AREAS THAT HAVE AN UNSUITABLE BASE, IF NEEDED. THE CONTRACTOR WILL RESURFACE THE TOP (2") LAYER OF ASPHALT PAVEMENT AFTER REPAIRS ARE COMPLETE, ON FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 2ND, WEATHER PERMITTING.

DURING THIS TIME, ACCESS TO THE DRIVEWAYS WILL BE LIMITED, NO PARKING WILL BE ALLOWED ALONG THE ROADS WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION ZONE.

ONCE THE ASPHALT LAYERS ARE PLACED AND COMPACTED, AND TEMPRATURE OF THE HOT ASPHALT IS SUITABLE TO DRIVE ON, RESIDENTS WILL BE PERMITTED TO NORMAL TRAFFIC. THE CONTACTOR WILL REMOVE THE CONSTRUCTION BARRICATES ONCE THE RESURFACED ROADS ARE DRIVABLE.

No parking will be allowed in the construction zone. Parking will be allowed at side streets outside the construction zone, see attached map for construction zone.

We apologize for the inconveniences this will create; however, with your cooperation, we can help to expedite the completion of the project.
