Dear Parents,

Next week we enter the month of May when we focus our love and attention on Mary, our mentor and model of faith. ## Mommy does God really Love Me?

Isn't it comforting when everything is in its place, everyone is acting how they are expected to act, and everyone is happy. What happens, however, when our children begin to think on their own. What happens when they have questions about God. You have taught them well, you are modeling faith, you go to church, they witness you in prayer, but what happens if they begin to wonder if there really is a God or if this God really loves them. It's a time when our heart sinks because this is big! How can they even wonder this?!

I think we need to take a moment and know that when our children grow, they begin to think...on their own...yes that can be scary 😊 but it is good! But we still ponder what if they get persuaded into not believing, not practicing our faith and lose their relationship with God?

I must believe, that if your child is baptized, you have provided a firm foundation of faith throughout their early years and growing up, and if you are still modeling prayer and participating at Mass ... *and you pray for your child by name, and you pray over your child...* God is going to take care of him/her. God may take them on a journey, but He knows them *even better* than you do and that's when our trust must be strong...God is working through you, other people and in your child.

Below is a prayer you can say, as you lay hands upon your child, if there has been a struggle in his/her heart. Also, I encourage you to Google *St. Monica*, mother of St. Augustine and read about her devotion to prayer for her son, who was everything but the saint he became. She and Mother Mary are loving intercessors for mothers.

*Loving Father,*

*You have gifted me with this precious child, my daughter/son (say name), whom I love with all my heart. Lord, (say name) needs to feel you with him/her. I know you are with him/her every day. I know how much you love him/her, and I know you are taking care of him/her. I pray that you send your Holy Spirit upon him/her, this moment. Let my sweet child feel your embrace, let him/her feel your love and feel your care. Allow (say name) the strength and courage to seek you, to listen for YOUR encouraging and loving voice. Let him/her know that no matter what he/she is thinking, or feeling, you will listen to him/her and continue to shower your grace upon him/her. Let (say name) know that whatever he/she is thinking, or feeling, that I will listen to him/her and continue to love him/her, with my whole being. Let (say name) know the same of you.*

*I trust in you Lord Jesus, that my precious child will grow close to you and will also trust in you. I thank you in advance for allowing (say name) to soon will feel burdens lifted, and joy will once again be part of his/her life.*

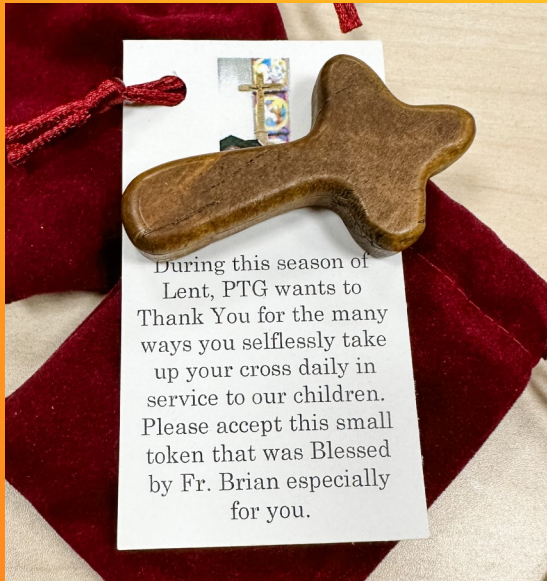
