Dear Parents,

The Easter Season will come to a close on Sunday, May 28 with the feast of Pentecost, when we are reminded how the disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit. St. Paul lists the fruits of the Holy Spirit as *love*, *joy*, *peace*, *patience*, *kindness*, *generosity*, *faithfulness*, *gentleness*, *and self-control*. Just as he did at Pentecost, Jesus wants to breathe God's life and the fruits of the Spirit into our hearts every day. When spending time with God in prayer, we feel energized by the Spirit, and we want to be like Jesus. We are moved to work for the kingdom, relying on the Spirit for love, guidance, and direction.

The Holy Spirit is alive at Holy Family Regional School. The school year is quickly coming to a close over the next couple of weeks. On Thursday, May 25, the South Campus faculty and students will gather to celebrate a special Eighth Grade Blessing Mass. This will be the last opportunity for our classes to celebrate the liturgy with our eighth grade. We wish many blessings on our eighth graders as they participate in the culminating events over the next two weeks.

A couple of weeks ago a survey was shared with our families regarding the hiring of security guards for our school. The results of the survey showed overwhelming support (91%) in favor of hiring the guards with an additional \$175 fee per family. The Finance Council and School Advisory Council have endorsed this initiative and will move forward with this for the 23-24 school year. The \$175 one-time fee will be billed to each family's FACTS account in August. In future years, this cost will be absorbed in tuition.

I am grateful for the additional layer of security for our school. The security guards will be retired police officers with specialized training in first response. They will be visible around our campuses, attend the all-school events and Masses, and assist during morning and afternoon pick-up and drop-off. They will be introduced to the children as part of the administrative staff who work together to keep our school safe. Special thanks to the committee for your time and efforts in making this happen for our school.

Once again, thank you to all the wonderful families of Holy Family Regional School for your dedication and support! It is an honor and blessing to serve this outstanding school community. I hold you in my daily prayers!

#### **On Our Blessed Mother Mary**

This month I have been sharing a timeline of the life of our Blessed Mother Mary. Last week I ended with the birth of our Savior Jesus. The next event we celebrate is the feast of The Presentation of the Lord on February 2nd .

After Jesus was born, Mary and Joseph took Jesus to the Temple forty days after birth to follow the Jewish tradition. They were to make a sacrifice and while many made the sacrifice of a lamb in the Temple, Mary and Joseph made the sacrifice of two turtledoves...since they were poor.

While in the Temple an old man named Simeon saw Jesus and exclaimed, "Lord now I may die in peace because I have seen our savior." He was told by the Holy Spirit that he would not die until he saw the face of the Messiah.

How incredible that the Holy Spirit was spreading the news in such an interesting way about Jesus' arrival to earth.

Twelve year old Jesus in the Temple (not a feast day but is the Fifth Joyful Mystery of the Rosary Luke 2:41-47)

Another interesting event in Mary's life was when she and Joseph traveled to Jerusalem for Passover. They went each year to celebrate this feast but one year, when Jesus was twelve years old, Mary and Joseph began their long way back to Nazareth and thought Jesus was with them. They were traveling in a caravan with many people and thought Jesus was among the group. They continued to travel for another day and looked among the crowd of relatives... but when they couldn't find him they went back to look for him along the way.

Can you imagine how Mary and Joseph must have felt when they realized Jesus was missing?

When Mary and Joseph reached the Temple and saw Jesus there, they were astonished (as the Bible tells us). Mary said, "Son why have you done this to us! Your father and I have been looking for you with great anxiety." But Jesus said to his parents, "Why were you looking for me? Didn't you realize I would be in my Father's house?"

The Bible tells us Mary and Joseph did not understand. They all returned to Nazareth and Mary kept all of this in her heart. Jesus continued to grow stronger in his devotion to, and his wisdom of, God. God and many people saw this.


