News from Campus Ministry

On Our Blessed Mother Mary

We continue to follow the timeline of Mother Mary's life that also involves her son, our Savior and Messiah, Jesus Christ. We don't have a certain day of the year that marks the next event but it's significance is Jesus' first miracle and how Mary was involved. It is the Wedding in Cana.

Mary and Jesus attended a wedding in the city of Cana. Many think it was a family wedding. The wine provided for the guests happens to run out. Mary told Jesus that there was not enough wine for all the guests. In those days, wine was the primary drink for many occasions. There wasn't lemonade, pop, Kool Aide, iced tea, and things like that. And Mary knew Jesus could do something miraculous...however, he told her his time had not yet come.

Just a note on some of the symbolism in this event...did you know that the wine running out represents the end of some of the old laws ... for instance sacrificing animals on the Altar. And the new wine represents the new covenant God has with the Church. Also, the fact that Mary told Jesus about the wine running out shows us that she works for us...she is an intercessor for us. If we talk to her, she will go to her son for us too. Of course, we should go to Jesus ourselves too, but she can help.

When Mary went to Jesus and told him that the wine had run out, he seems to say, why are you telling me this? If I fix this problem, people will start to see that I am not just the son of a carpenter, but they will begin to realize I am the Son of God... we know what happens when people realized that!

Jesus also was saying to Mary that her role would change too...and wondered if she was ready for that. She wouldn't just be the mother of Jesus of Nazareth but the mother of the universe...the mother of all people!

Jesus did listen to his mother and told the servants to bring two containers of water to him and he turned that water into wine. The father of the bride received many compliments that the new wine was even better than the wine served earlier in the evening.

What is PENTECOST?



PENTECOST comes from the Greek word "Pentecoste" meaning 50th day.
Pentecost Sunday is one of the most prominent feast days in the Christian calendar. It is often referred to as the "BIRTHDAY OF THE CHURCH".

It marks the day when the HOLY SPIRIT descended upon the Apostles, who had been living in fear for fifty days following the resurrection of Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday.

On Pentecost, the HOLY SPIRIT came down visibly on the Apostles. He gave them the power to speak in strange tongues to the crowds that came to Jerusalem for that Feast. He also transformed them, from selfish and timid men into giants of courage and faith.

Schedule your sports physical for the 2023-2024 school year NOW. Physicals must be dated on or after April 15, 2023. The Athletic Department must have your child's physical on file before they can participate in any sport during the 2023-2024 school year.

Uniform Return

Athletes can drop off their uniforms outside the gym on the labeled metal rack or in one of the bins.
