

This Week in our Faith

News from Campus Ministry

On Our Blessed Mother Mary

As we come to the end of May we have two more significant events to ponder in the life of our Blessed Mother. First is the Assumption of Mary.

Sadly, we do not know the day or year that Mary died. Some think maybe it was three to fifteen years after Jesus ascended into Heaven. Believe it or not, we are not sure she even died on earth. We do believe that her body and soul were taken directly up to Heaven. So, the next event in Mary's life is her Assumption into Heaven...and it is celebrated on August 15th.

Our Catholic Church teaches and believes that Mary was taken full body and spirit directly into Heaven. Theologians who study scripture, and study God, teach this by examining the words in the book of Genesis (3:5), 1 Corinthians (15:54) and chapter 12 of the book of Revelation. Some believe her assumption happened in the town of Ephesus, others say in Jerusalem.

The next event of Mary is when she was crowned Queen in Heaven...the Coronation of Mary. While we celebrate Mary's crowning at the beginning of the month of May it was originally celebrated on May 31st (the end of Mary's month). However, our Church now celebrates her crowning just a few days before her entering Heaven. The crowning of Mary, or her coronation, is on August 22nd.

There are places in the Bible that indicate her title of Queen. The Angel Gabriel told Mary that her son Jesus would receive the throne of King David...the mother of a King is a queen. Jesus is our King and just like kings of countries, he is the authority. Mary is the Queen.

The queen's job on earth is to stand by the king, to offer support, but to not make any decisions... she is not in authority. However, a queen often quietly whispers in the ear of the king to maybe help him think about a decision...maybe to influence his decision. Do you remember the wedding in Cana...isn't that what Mary did? She didn't tell Jesus what to do, but she told him there was not enough wine and then she told the servants to do whatever Jesus told them to do. She whispered in his ear.

Spring Sports Uniform Return!

TRACK - Monday, June 5th 8-12:

Return washed shorts and jerseys in a Ziploc bag with <u>your runner's t-shirt and short size, and</u>

<u>your last name clearly labeled</u>

(Smith, XL shirt, L shorts).

LACROSSE - Monday June 5th 8-12:

Return your player's washed uniform in a bag <u>clearly labeled with the player's name and uniform</u> size. Helmets should be labeled also, but please do not write directly on the helmets (use tape).

DO NOT return practice jerseys as players can keep those for next year. 8th graders can keep the practice jersey.

Anyone with lost or damaged uniforms will be required to pay a replacement fee

Summer Open Gym:

Players can expect some time spent on drills, some technique work, and some time scrimmaging full court. Doors will open 15 minutes prior to each session. Transfer your Google data!



PLEASE NOTE: Google may not provide all the storage space needed to transfer all your files. You may have to be selective or clean up your drive before transferring your data.

Special Note to Staff: If you have shared documents with other staff members, you must transfer ownership in order for them to have access after your departure. Only files you own will be exported during the Google transfer. Please DO NOT export any files with student information or data.

Your @holyfam.org Google Workspace for Education account will be deleted on June 30, 2023. If you want to keep your personal files, you'll need to transfer those to another location before that date!

- Google Takeout is a data transfer utility that will transfer all your holyfam.org Google Drive files from your Holy Family account to a personal Google account. It may take a while depending on the amount and size of your files, but when the process is complete, you'll get an email at your personal Gmail address.
- You'll have the month of June to do so, giving you time after you graduate from Holy Family.
