Another busy week of learning for our students! Earth day celebrations led to lessons on caring for our earth, learning about plants and animals. We also learned about habitats and many new words were mastered, books have been read, and we have grown in our relationship with Jesus. Our students love to grow their brains.

Next week, our 6th graders will make their yearly pilgrimage to the Father Solanus Casey Center. Please pray for them, may the time at the center be filled with intentional growth in relationship with God.

I am taking a group of 7th graders on *The Road to Emmaus Project* completed by students at Holy Redeemer School in Detroit. This group will learn from the other students how to embark on a deeper faith journey, how to guide younger students in prayer, reflection, and retreat. As 8th graders, they will have the opportunity for this leadership, and to help with times of prayer, reflection, and retreats for their younger classmates. I am excited to begin this journey with this group of thirteen seventh graders.

We have been blessed with Miss Darnell as one of our Spanish teachers at the south campus. Unfortunately, her last day with us will be Thursday, May 9th. We wish Miss Darnell well, and we will continue to hold her in prayers.

Please keep our second graders in prayer this weekend as more will come to receive Holy Eucharist for the first time. We had several receive today at the school Mass for the first time. Welcome to the table of the Lord!




