- 21K in the checking account. We have some outstanding expenses. Fall Fest has some invoices. Based on today's meeting re:SAW, we'll be reallocating some funds among the programs. We will update and redistribute. Flower sale was extremely successful. \$2,094 profit. Projected only \$1,000. 9K was projected for Fall Festival. Came in at \$5,500, including next year's deposit. Ticket sales were phenomenal. Ticket sales were 26K. Martial arts budget \$900 projected. Came in at \$825. 33 kids.Trunk or treat doing well with sales. The pizza revenue is part of the overall budget. 208 tickets as of this am. Pizza sales so far = 96 cheese, 80 pepperoni. Will need detailed budgets for each event. Trunk or treat profit budget is \$3k. Budget will be edited throughout the year based on revenue from earlier events. Expense reimbursements. Do direct vendor payments as much as possible. 50/50 and raffles We are required to have a raffle license any time we have raffles. We need to be mindful of the tax rules. Forms may need to be filed if over the \$600 threshold. Motion to look into "Share the Wealth" info. Some 50/50 raffles for later events may be reworked per Lisa Davis.
