At Holy Family Regional School, our Special Services TEAM includes administrators, teachers, specialists, and a school counselor. The Special Services Team incorporates a positive school-wide identification and intervention process for our Young 5 through eighth grade students. Together, school administrators, teachers, parents and students design accommodation plans based on students' identified strengths, needs, and learning styles. Accommodations may include learning strategies, academic interventions, counseling, behavior interventions, small group learning environments in language arts and math, and test support. The TEAM meets regularly to monitor the progress of the students' achievements. Collaboration with the Rochester Community Schools TEAM provides additional expertise to our Special Services TEAM.
